

Grandma's Garden Bag

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Grandma's Garden Collection)

Fabric 1: Fat¼ - A198.3 (Bird houses on lilac) Fabric 2: Fat¼ - A199.1 (Garden gnomes on white)

Wadding and lining: 1/2mtr

CUTTING

1. From fabric 1 cut: 2 x 8½"(h) x 12½" 4 x 3½" x 8½"(sides) 2 x 3½" x 12½" 2 x 3" x 12½" handles 2. From fabric 2 cut: 4 x 4½" x 12½" Wadding handles 2 x 1" x 12½"

MAKING UP THE BAG

Pockets

With right sides together, stitch across the top of each pocket and turn to the right side, press

Place this onto the main bag panel at the bottom and pin into place

Next sew the sides onto the bag and then the bottom strips

Cut out your wadding and lining to the same size as the outer part of bag

Place the outer part of the bag onto the wadding. Stitch down half of the bag pocket. So this will give you two pockets

Now sew down the sides and across the bottom on the outer and lining of the bag

Stitch across the open seam at the bottom of bag outer and lining

Turn the outer bag to the right side and place the lining into the bag

Handles

Turn in a ¼" on the length on each side of the handles and then press in half. Place the wadding in to the fold and top stitch down

Next take your bag and turn in a 1/4" on the outer and lining of the bag

Place the handles into the bag, pin and top stitch around the bag
