## Fabric Needed

## 3 Wishes Fabric ${ }^{\oplus}$ Everyday is Caturday Collection

- 1 yd - Floral (18038-COR-CTN-D) for Piecing and Binding
- $1 / 2 \mathrm{yd}$ - Cat Patch (18036-BLU-CTN-D)


## Additional Supplies Needed:

- 58 " x 58" (147.32 cm x 147.32 cm ) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- $1 / 2$ yd - White Cats (18039-MNT-CTN-D)
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- $1 / 3 \mathrm{yd}$ - Plants (18037-WHT-CTN-D)
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)
- $1 / 3 \mathrm{yd}$ - Packed Cats ( $18040-\mathrm{MLT-CTN}-\mathrm{D}$ )
- $21 / 2$ yds - Plants (18037-WHT-CTN-D) Backing-Directional

From the 3 Wishes Fabric ${ }^{\circledR}$ Painted Soul Collection

- $11 / 4 \mathrm{yds}$ - White on White Leaf (18058-WOW-CTN-D)

Fabric collection ships to stores beginning July 2021.

## Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. woof = width of fabric

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below. Note: It will be helpful to group and label the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{112 "}{}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares with the fabric name as they are cut.

White on White Leaf - 18058-WOW-CTN-D ( $11 / 4$ gds x wof / $114.3 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) from the 3W Painted Soul Collection
Cut $48-51 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 22^{\prime \prime}(13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm})$


Floral - 18030-COR-CTN-D ( 1 yd x wof / $91.44 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut 6-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ whf ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) for Binding
Cut 3 - $10 \frac{112 "}{} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}(26.67 \mathrm{~cm} \times 26.67 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $36-21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$


Cat Patch - 18036-BLU-CTN-D ( $1 / 2 y$ yd $x$ wof $/ 45.72 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut 3 - $101 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "(26.67 \mathrm{~cm} \times 26.67 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $18-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$


White Cats - 18039-MNT-CTN-D ( $1 / 2$ yd $x$ whf $/ 45.72$ cm x 106.68 cm)

Cut $16-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$


Plants - 18037-WHT-CTN-D ( $1 / 3$ yd x wof / $30.48 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut 2 - $10 \frac{112 "}{} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}(26.67 \mathrm{~cm} \times 26.67 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $12-21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 21 ⁄ 22^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$


Packed Cats - 18040-MLT-CTN-D ( $1 / 3$ yd x whf $/ \mathbf{3 0 . 4 8} \mathbf{~ c m ~ x ~} 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut 2 - $10 \frac{1 ⁄ 2 " ~}{} \times 101 / 22^{\prime \prime}(26.67 \mathrm{~cm} \times 26.67 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $14-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 22^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 6.35 \mathrm{~cm})$

## Sewing

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a Floral square ( $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} / 6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 6.35 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Place the square on one corner of a White on White Leaf square ( $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime} / 13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), sew on the drawn line and trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~mm}$ ) away from the sewn line; press. Repeat with the opposite corner to make a Floral/Floral X-Block Unit ( $51 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2 " / 13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Make two.

2. Repeat the technique in Step 1 to make the following $X$ - Block Units. Follow Diagram $B$ using a White on White Leaf square ( $51 / 2$ " $\times 5 \frac{1 ⁄ 2 "}{} / 13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) with two print squares ( $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} / 6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 6.35 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) placed on opposite corners. Make the number shown in the diagram for each fabric combination. Tip: Pin a label with the Unit name as they are sewn.

3. Make the first X-Block using the following method. Place one Floral/Floral, one Floral/Packed Cats, one Cat Patch/Floral and one Cat Patch/Packed Cats X-Block Units ( $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime} / 13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) in two rows as shown in Diagram C. Pin the pieces in each row RST, sew and press. Pin the rows RST matching seams, sew and press to make one X-Block R-1 C-2 ( $5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ $/ 13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Follow Step 4 to put the remaining X-Block Units together after they are placed in the Quilt layout to ensure correct placement.

4. Lay out the three Floral, three Cat Patch, three White Cats, two Plants and two Packed Cats Print squares ( $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ $/ 26.67 \mathrm{~cm} \times 26.67 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram D. Next, place the individual X-Block Units ( $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime} / 13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) in groups of four between the $10 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}(26.67 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares. Note: The triangle prints match the adjacent print square. The triangles facing the outside edges are Floral and match the Binding. Make the X-Blocks according to the method in Step 3 and return to their position in the Quilt layout. Pin the Print squares and Blocks in each row RST, sew and press. Each row should measure $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 501 / 2$ " ( $26.67 \mathrm{~cm} \times 128.27 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Tip: Pin a label with the Row and Column number to each Print square and X-Block.

5. Place the rows as shown in Diagram E. Pin RST, sew and press. The Everyday is Caturday Quilt Top should measure $501 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 501 / 2{ }^{1 / 2}$ ( $128.27 \mathrm{~cm} \times 128.27 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).


## Finishing

6. Remove the selvages from the Plants Backing fabric. Note: Fabric is directional. Cut one piece $401 / 4 " \times 58^{\prime \prime}(102.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 147.32 \mathrm{~cm})$ and two pieces $18 \frac{1}{4 \prime \prime} \times 291 / 4^{\prime \prime}(46.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 74.3 \mathrm{~cm})$. Pin the two smaller pieces RST on the short edges and sew; press. Pin the two sections RST and sew the long edges as shown in Diagram F. Press seams open or to one side. The Backing should measure 58 " x 58 " ( $147.32 \mathrm{~cm} \times 147.32 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
7. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing, wrong side up, to a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
8. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.

9. Binding - Follow Diagram G to make the Floral Binding. Remove selvages and sew the short ends of the six $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ wof strips RST end to end at a $45^{\circ}$ angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a 2 " $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.


## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
