$12 \times 2 ½$ " H x 81⁄212" W (block 5)

All of the blocks are made up in the same way. 13 will be with the strips gong up as in block 1. The other 12 will have the strips going across the as in block 2.

Look at the main diagram for the fabric lay out on each block.
Sew the strips together to make up the block. 5 of each colour way.
25 blocks in total for the quilt.

## Assembling quilt

Lay out the blocks, sashing strips and squares as in the main diagram.


Four of the rows from the top. Your first row will be square and then a sashing strip. Stitch all the pieces together on the top row.

The next row will be a sashing strip and then the block.
Work along the row until you end with a sashing strip.
Sew all the rows and then stitch your rows together to complete the quilt center.

## Border

For the sides you need to make up 2 strips $2 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 461 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Sew to the sides of the quilt and press back.
Top \& bottom
$2 \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 501 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to complete the quilt sew to the top and bottom.

## Quilting and binding

Sandwich the quilt top, wadding and backing together.
Quilt by hand or machine as desired.
Trim the backing and wadding to size of quilt.
Bind quilt with fabric 7 .

$6 \times 21 / 2 " \mathrm{H} \times 81 / 2 \mathrm{~L}$ W (block 3)

## From fabric 4 cut

$18 \times 211 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ (block 4)

## From fabric 5 cut

$3 \times 21 / 2{ }^{2} \mathrm{~W} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H}$ (block 5)
$12 \times 211 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \times 81 / 22^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ (block 5)
From fabric 6 cut
$60 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2$ " for sashing
